## About the College

To uphold the Sanatan values of life and to render quality education Brahmavart Sanatan Dharam Mahamandal, the parent body of Vikramajit Singh Sanatan Dharam College, Kanpur was founded in 1916, seeking inspiration from Swami Dayanandji, a great philosopher and promoter of Hindu Dharam. However, the Sanatan Dharam College, later known as Vikramajit Singh Sanatan Dharam College, Kanpur was established in 1921 under the guardianship of Rai Bahadur Babu Vikamajit Singh. From its very inception, the college was famous as a college of commerce to award Diploma in commerce was affiliated to Bombay University. In 1923 the college got affiliation from Allahabad University, Allahabad to award degree of Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com.). The classes for Bachelor's and Master's degree in different other subjects began in 1925. Later in 1927 the college was affiliated to Agra University and LL. B. classes started in 1928. B.Sc. classes were started in 1956 whereas the M.Sc. classes began in 1964. Since 1967, the college is affiliated to C. S. J. M. University Kanpur. The College has been accredited 'A' grade by NAAC in 2009 & 2016 cycles The college presently runs study programs under sixteen departments of six different faculties, namely, Arts, Commerce, Science, Teacher Education, Law and Physical Education. The College has celebrated its centenary in 2021. The Department of Law has been actively involved in legal research and organizing seminars, workshops etc.

## Theme of the Seminar

The right to health, a universally accepted human right for all, has got legal recognition in various international, regional and national instruments. This right is directly related with survival, existence and well-being of every individual and because of its

significance it has been said that health is wealth. In present environment, our life is being impacted by various components like social conditions, pollution, harmful edible substances, food and fruits, current life-style, non-scientific disposal of wastes, traffic accidents, use of narcotic drugs and substances etc. adversely affecting the quality of life and shortening the natural life tenure which frustrates the objectives of the right to health.

India, being a welfare State, is under duty to fulfill essential needs to its citizens which are necessary for their well-being, existence and survival. Though the Constitution of India does not specifically mention about this right but the Indian Judiciary has evolved this right by liberally interpreting the constitutional provisions particularly Article 21. In India, healthcare services are provided by both private and public sectors. It is the responsibility of the public sector to establish healthcare institutions accessible to all sections of the population in all parts of the country, to provide diagnostic and treatment facilities.

In the light of above facts and for effective academic deliberation ensuring the right to health, this seminar is intended to provide an open platform for the academicians including teachers, research scholars and students to come up with a concrete conclusion with their thought provoking presentations.
